Shared Values and Vision Exercise (40 min. Max)

Pair up with one other Commissioner who you are not already acquainted with. Take a few minutes to briefly introduce yourself to your partner and then:

- 1) Share one or two key points/ strengths/ or skills about yourself that you believe will be impactful to the Commission.

- 2) Each person share a very brief story about when you served on a board or team and it was very effective. Explain in your story the values or traits you believe the board or team embraced that made it successful.

Be sure to note the values from one another's stories and develop a collective list of values to share with the group

- 3) Envision the future together. You are in 2027. Generally, what has a very successful Commission accomplished in the past (4) years? What does the community say about you as a group?

Each pair will introduce themselves by sharing their combined strengths; report their collective values and vision of Commission 2027 to the group. This information will be used to begin the design process of a shared values and vision for this term.
