The Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office is required by law to obtain and to disclose to the defense any and all potential impeachment evidence relative to its witnesses. Potential impeachment evidence includes, but is not limited to, any disciplinary actions against officers and any instances involving dishonesty or a lack of candor, or a demonstration of bias. The Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office has determined that the enclosed material we received on 10/03/2018 and 10/19/2018 is NOT potential impeachment evidence: Divisional Notice of 05/23/2018 received on 10/03/2018 and a 1-page synopsis of Sgt. Kortan's disciplinary history received from IA Superintendent Bakeman on 10/19/2018.

We respectfully request that you notify Sgt. Kortan of this decision.

Failure to investigate three Use of Less Lethal Force investigations and insubordination

- Advised of late reports on July 9, 2015, and told to have the reports completed by July 22, 2015.
- On August 4, reports still not completed
- 6 day suspension

Failure to submit timely two (2) injury packets as of December 11, 2015

- Date officer injured and assigned to investigate was April 26, 2015
- Failure to timely investigate resulted in officers having to use accumulated sick hours (brought to attention of PD due grievance being filed)
- 5 day suspension

Sent out flyer in December 2015, offering a reward to the Officer issuing the most tickets

- Admitted to issuing the flyer
- 4 day suspension

Late reporting for duty (38 minutes) on May 23, 2016, and did not notify Supervisor

- Investigation by Inspections Unit, #2016-0086
- 3 day suspension

Failure to investigate an allegation of domestic violence on September 29, 2016

- Failure to notify IA
- IA investigation, CPD 2016-0148
- 7 day suspension

Failure to submit timely four (4) injury packets as of November 10, 2017

- District investigation
- P.O. Zeitz / P.O. Fedorko injured on September 15, 2017.
- P.O. Onofrei / P.O. Choat injured on August 17, 2017
- 14 day suspension
